CONSIDERING THAT:

- A) Today, 24th April, 2018, the Equine Auction took place, according to the duly published Regulations.
- B) The Buyer states that they have full knowledge of the Auction Regulations and accept all the conditions set out therein.
- C) The Buyer declares that had access to the following medical and veterinary exams: x-rays of distal limbs, hock and stifle – for the males - and breeding soundness evaluation including ultrasound examination - for the females - (made by the vets of the University of Évora at the stud clinic), prior to the auction and that, pursuant to Auction Regulations, the horses available for sale have been available for viewing and analysis by interested parties and there was opportunity to perform an examination by a veterinarian of their choice and of their responsibility, on the horse now purchased at the auction. Having noted that the animal is in good condition of animal health and physically fit for the purposes for which it is intended, the buyer recognises said horse's fitness, taking into account its medical and veterinary conditions and therefore renounces from now on, any right of return of the horse or the annulment of the contract.

1. The above-identified buyer declares that they have purchased on this date, the horse named _____, registered under No. _____ son of _____ and of _____ of **PUREBRED LUSITANO BREED** at a price of € _____ (_____), which is the value corresponding to the winning bid without VAT at the legal rate.

2. The Buyer also declares they are aware and have been duly informed that this purchase is made under the conditions outlined in the Auction Regulations, in the Considerations above and in particular on the following terms and conditions:

- a) Payment will be made at the end of the Auction, on this date, at the Stud Office, by bank transfer/ credit or debit card (delete as appropriate).
- b) The horse can only be collected from Coudelaria de Alter (Alter Stud Farm), by the Buyer, after its effective and full payment and signature of the respective Auction Sale agreement.
- c) The buyer declares that from the signature of the Sale Agreement or the payment in full of the purchased horse, is solely responsible for any damage or injury caused by the horse to property or persons, of third parties, or their own and takes full responsibility for transport of the horse, including the cost of transportation, insurance and damage from any possible accident to the animal itself or caused to third parties, excluding Companhia das Lezírias S.A. in any sort of responsibility for these facts.
- d) Any damage suffered by the horse at the time of loading at Coudelaria de Alter (Alter Stud Farm) is the sole responsibility of the buyer identified herein and should be borne by him.
- e) The buyer must collect the horse by 4th May 2018 the latest.
- f) If the buyer does not collect the horse(s) within the prescribed period, without prior information to the Stud about the reason why, will lose not only the amount paid so far, by way of damages for breach of contract, but also the right to collect the horse(s) concerned, and the purchase and sale agreement will be immediately resolved, with all legal and appropriate effects.
- g) Following the above mentioned payment and until the actual collection of the horse a daily amount of 20 euros will be charged to the Buyer per horse, for boarding, plus VAT at the current rate (includes stabling, feed and exercise). Boarding will have to be paid for before the horse is actually collected.
